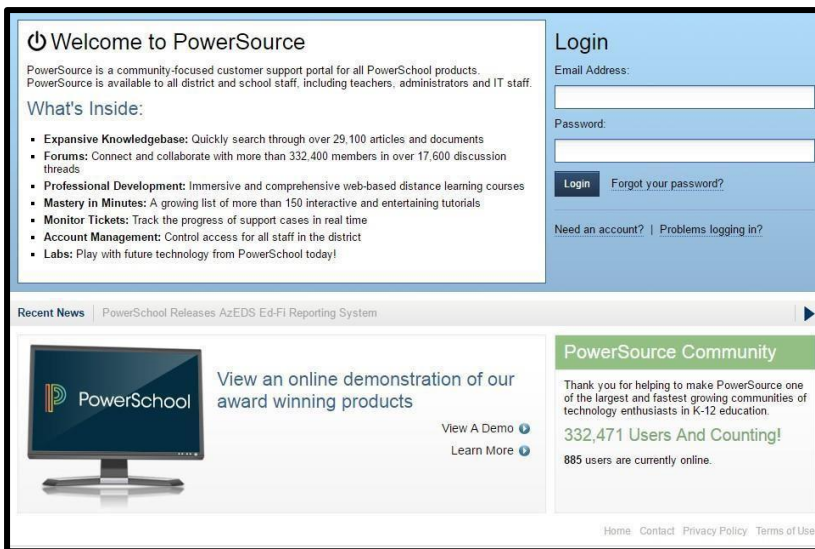


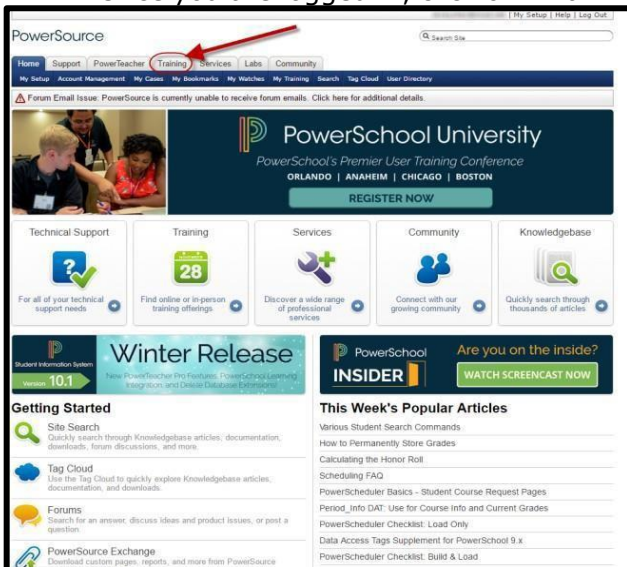
PowerSource: How to Navigate to the Mastery in Minutes Videos and Distance Learning Courses

You will need a PowerSource account in order to login to PowerSource. If you do not have one, please contact your district PowerSchool Liaison.

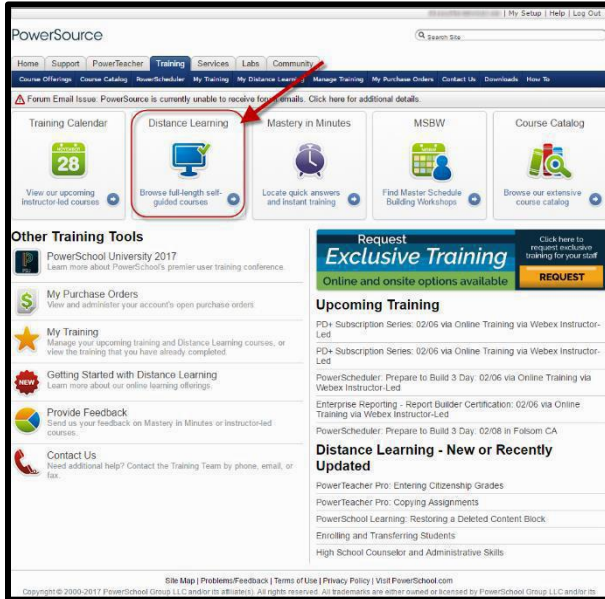


- Once you are logged in, click on "Training".

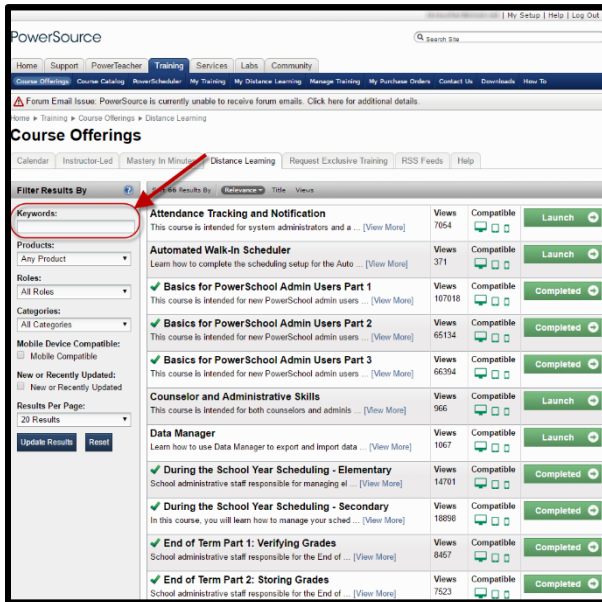

- Then, click on "Distance Learning".

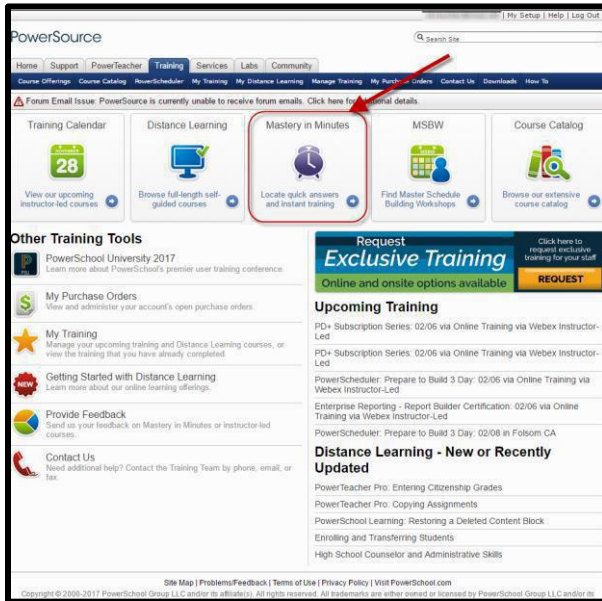

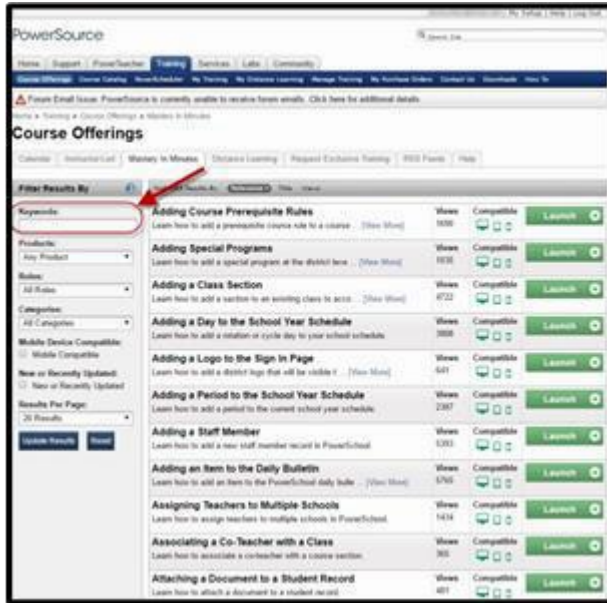
